Over the next twenty-four months, I will be compiling a book consisting of portraits of people accompanied by a quote from someone close to them—perhaps their child, or brother, sister, husband, or wife, or even a friend and associate. (The quote would be something you need to say but have not been able to, for whatever reason).

If requested for privacy, only first names will be used in the book.

I offer a free portrait session of a person that will accompany an old photograph that relates to their life story. I can help edit the information you supply for the life story and assist with shaping the quote for the best emotional response for the reader.

I will photograph the person in his or her best light in a non-staged and un-interrupted environment. My purpose is to capture the beauty and essence of that person.

The participants in this project will be selected on the merit of the quote supplied.

The format of my book is as follows: Each story is a two-page layout. Please reference the various stories on my website that will better illustrate the design. The page on the left is divided into two sections.

The Left section is a quote that you provide to me on how this person affected you.

The Right section begins with the person's first name only and a brief history of what events or circumstances has shaped their character.

The right side of the two-page spread is the portrait that I will take that best illustrates the story and character of this person.

Once I receive your information, we can set a time that is convenient for you to have a telephone call to discuss the project further. I look forward to meeting you and doing the photo session.
